Dear Friends,

We believe that God has called us to Nicaragua to spend a lifetime of ministry as lights in this very poor country where poverty and darkness abound. To that end, we moved here permanently with all our belongings in January 2007.

With the economic downturn, our source of personal income (royalties from a company we sold) has dried up and we will need to spend part of the year in the US working to support ourselves. This is not what we planned, but it is not a tragedy either.

God is faithful and is the architect of all that happens in our lives. The important thing is that our vision has not changed. We are still committed to a lifetime of ministry here.

The ministry in Bluefields will continue, even with our periodic absences:

1. We have a full time music teacher in Nehemiah. He is very faithful and talented and he takes in all the students at no charge. His salary costs us \$200 per month and with your faithful contributions that will continue.
2. We are starting to bring in neighborhood kids for computer classes, music classes. They also come in to play dominoes and use our small computer lab.
3. We are planning to start Sunday Morning Café soon, a way to plant spiritual seeds among the neighbors by bringing them in for coffee, donuts and a word of encouragement. This can also continue in our absence.
4. We will continue to teach the leadership training classes and computer classes when we are here and we hope to recruit others who will come with us to teach.

Your financial support will insure that these ministries continue. We use your donations solely for the support of the ministry work, not for our living costs.

Please pray for God to open just the right doors of opportunity for us. We need work that will still allow us to spend several months each year in Nicaragua. Our long-term goal is to be able to live full-time in Nicaragua again.

We do not consider the time we spend in the US as wasted time. God clearly has a reason for bringing us back for a season and we will be in ministry wherever we are.
